



The Lamprobe is an instrument (i.e. probe) that rapidly and successfully treats a variety of common skin conditions such as moles, age spots, skin tags, broken capillaries, milia, enlarged oil glands etc. giving the skin a bumpy texture. These treatments are designed to restore your skin to its healthy, vibrant and youthful state. The theory behind the treatment is quite simple~blood is naturally drawn towards the heat source emitted from the probe. The Lamprobe emits radio frequency energy that is applied to your skin for about 3 - 5 seconds per shot. When the heated probe touches your skin, blood flow to the treatment area is sealed off causing the cells to evaporate killing them instantly and ensuring they will never return. Another benefit is the quick recovery time. Most Lamprobe patients are able to return to their normal activities within 24 hrs and notice a positive change in the treated area within a week. It will truly change your skin!

You can return to your normal routine immediately. There may be a slight redness, small scab or crusting for a few days after. It is recommended that the treated area stay dry at least 24 hr. and apply a thin layer of antibiotic ointment for a few days.
